

ISBNs, Copyrights & More

ISBN: If you plan to sell your book, you must have an ISBN code. An ISBN (International Standard Book Number) is required for books sold through retail channels such as Amazon or wholesalers such as Baker & Taylor. You can purchase an ISBN from Vervante or use one that you may have purchased online. Vervante sells ISBN numbers and you may purchase them directly from your Author Dashboard. If you purchase your ISBN through Vervante, you are the sole owner of that number and Vervante retains no rights to it or your content.

Universal Product Code (UPC): A UPC bar code is required for CD or DVD products sold through retail channels such as Amazon. Vervante sells UPC codes and you may purchase them directly from your Author Dashboard. If you purchase a UPC from Vervante you own the UPC and Vervante has no rights to the UPC or your content.

Managing Your ISBNs and UPCs: Once you purchase ISBNs or UPCs from Vervante, you will be able to access them all from your Author Dashboard. Just click on the “Manage ISBN Titles” or “Manage UPC titles” links visible in the ISBN & UPC section.

Library of Congress Control Number (LCCN): The LCCN number is a unique identification number that the Library of Congress assigns to titles. This is not the same as a copyright registration with the Library of Congress. There is no charge for registering your book with the Library of Congress, or you can submit the form available in your account and we will process the LCCN assignment. You can complete the Application to Participate online and you will receive an account number and password, usually within two weeks. Once the book is complete you can send a copy to the Library of Congress. If you would like our team at Vervante to submit the LCCN application, please complete the form in your account.

Copyright Registration: Copyright registration of your book is important and a simple task that will protect you and your book. For more details and to register your book, go to <http://www.copyright.gov/>. If you would like our team at Vervante to submit the registration and send the book for you, please complete the form in your account. The physical certificate will be mailed to you directly from the Copyright Office.

Uploading Your Files

We’re excited that your files are ready to go! Here are the quick-and-easy steps for uploading them to Vervante HQ.

- Log in to your Author Dashboard by clicking on the “Log In” button on the Vervante website.
- Click on the link that says “Upload Files”
- You will go to a page called “Specification Document.” Find the section for the type of project you are submitting (book, CD, binder, etc.) and fill out as much information as you can for the product’s specifications. Click on the “Submit” button at the bottom and you will be taken to a link for attaching and uploading your files.

Print files should be in a PDF format.

Audio files should be mp3 or wav files.

DVD products require a physical DVD master.

Adding extra items

You are welcome to include items with your information product that we don't produce such as a t-shirt, special markers or a gift for your customer. Please include this information with your quote request. We will assign a part number to these items and you can send these to our production facility. When you're ready to send the extra items in, please email customerservice@vervante.com, let us know what your plans are, and we will provide you with the address and a form to be included with the shipment. Please include the part number when you send these items. We'll receive the items into inventory and you can keep track of the quantities by checking your Inventory Report available from your Author Dashboard.

OOPS – you found a mistake! No worries – You are welcome to send us updated files for your product at any time. There is no charge for changes.

We move quickly here at Vervante so that your products can be shared with the world as soon as possible. As soon as we receive your print-ready files, your new product will be accessible via your personal Vervante Author Dashboard within 24-48 hours. If there are any issues, we will let you know. If not, you will receive an email once it has been added to your Author Dashboard. As soon as you see the product listed in your Author Dashboard, you can start placing orders right away.

We have no shopping cart preference and we can process your orders from any shopping cart or merchant solution. Orders can be processed in four basic ways:

- Automatically processed from emails generated from your shopping cart or other application.
- Automatically processed from an email notification set up in the Vervante-specified format outlined below.
- You can log into your Vervante account and manually place orders.
- Sending orders by email to orders@vervante.com for processing.

PLEASE NOTE: Each of your products with Vervante will be assigned a part number. This part number must be included on all emailed order requests.

Would you like to add your book, CD, DVD or information product to the Vervante public bookstore and let us take care of the hassle of credit card transactions and fulfillment? Books and other information products such as CDs, DVDs, coaching or training programs can be listed on Vervante.com or Amazon.com. Only books can be listed with Barnes & Noble and Baker & Taylor. All activity is available in your online account. Each month we will reconcile sales of your products and send you a statement. If you have a credit of less than \$100 the balance will remain in your account. If the credit is more than \$100 or once your account reaches \$100 for sales we will send you a check or refund via PayPal.

Amazon Marketplace

Amazon Marketplace is the most popular option because Amazon only takes a 15% discount plus \$1.35 per transaction fee. We receive the orders when your book or product is purchased on Amazon. The transaction is entered in your order report in your author account so you will see all transactions. Amazon pays Vervante for transactions and we will reconcile your Amazon purchases with your monthly invoice. You set the retail price for the book in Amazon Marketplace. The Vervante printing and postage costs are just examples. The actual printing cost is based on the actual book specs and the postage is based on weight and shipping method.

Amazon Advantage

Amazon Advantage is a consignment program with Amazon. When we list your book in this program, Amazon will order usually 1-2 initial copies for their inventory. When the book is sold, Amazon will ship the book directly to the customer and will take a 55% discount on the retail price of the book. You are also responsible for the postage costs to ship the book to Amazon.

Barnes & Noble.com is a consignment program. When we list your book in this program, BN.com will order usually 1-2 initial copies for their inventory. When the book is sold, BN.com will ship the book directly to the customer and will take a 40% discount on the retail price of the book. You are also responsible for the postage costs to ship the book to BN.com.

Baker & Taylor

Baker & Taylor is one of the largest wholesale distributors. We can list your book in their database and then any book reseller can order and stock your book in their store. Baker & Taylor sells and distributes to book stores, internet and physical locations, such as Amazon, Border, Barnes & Noble, etc. If your book is listed in the Baker & Taylor database, a customer can also special order the book from any bookstore. Baker & Taylor takes a 55% discount off of the price of the book and you pay for shipping to the Baker & Taylor warehouse. There are no pre-orders with this program. Baker & Taylor will only order your book if they have an order for the book.

NOTE

Please note that there are some risks associated with listing your book with Amazon Advantage, Barnes & Noble and Baker & Taylor. These are:

1. Your suggested list price may not be what the book is actually listed for on these sites. These companies may chose to list your book at a discounted price and you may then have a competitive situation where you have the book listed on your site for the full list price and the distributor may be selling it at a discount.
2. If you list your book with Baker & Taylor, Amazon may import this listing and chose to sell your book at a discount. The book on Amazon will show "Out of Stock" and may never show in stock because Amazon might list the book but never order it from Baker & Taylor.

We highly recommend the Amazon Marketplace option for a few important reasons:

- You control the list price
- The product is never out of stock
- We ship the product so you know who is buying your book
- You pay 15% commission plus \$1.35 per transaction and you are reimbursed \$3.99 for postage and shipping
- We have full control over the listing so if you want to make changes or update the product description or price, we can do this for you quickly and easily

If you would like your book listed in any of these distribution channels, we need the following information.

An ISBN number (International Standard Book Number) is required for books and CDs sold through retail channels such as Amazon or Baker & Taylor.

A UPC code (Universal Product Code) is required for a DVD product sold through retail channels such as Amazon.

Vervante sells ISBN and UPC codes. You can purchase these from your Author Dashboard. If you would like to list your book in any of these retail channels, please complete the retail listing form available from your Author Dashboard.

We can list your eBook for sales on Amazon Kindle and Barnes & Noble Nook.

You will be paid a royalty off the List Price according to the following terms:

Barnes & Noble Nook

You must ensure that the eBook List Price:

- You set the List Price for each eBook between \$0.99 and \$199.99. You will be paid a royalty off the List Price according to the following terms

Shipping

Most products are shipped via the US Postal Service. If a product weighs less than 13 ounces it is shipped via 1st Class Mail. Orders weighing more than 13 ounces are sent via Priority Mail. We send international orders via the Postal Service via 1st Class (under four pounds) or Priority Mail (over 4 pounds). Media Mail is also available for shipments in the U.S. We offer UPS services for expedited shipping in the US and worldwide. If you have an event or a deadline, please place the order and email customerservice@vervante.com with the order number and deadline so we can prioritize and expedite the order and ship accordingly.

We automatically ship your products using the least expensive shipping method based on the weight and zip/postal code used. However, you can select a shipping method that best fits your needs. If you want to designate a specific default shipping method for any of your products, you can make that determination from your dashboard.

Shipping Notification Emails

If an email address is included in your product order, Vervante will send an automated email to that address that includes:

- The tracking number
- The ship date
- The name of the business the product shipped from. (Note: This is automatically filled in using the entry you made on your author dashboard profile for “business name.”)

If you prefer that customers do not receive shipping notification emails, send us an email at customerservice@vervante.com and we can turn them off.

NOTE: Shipping notification emails and packing slips do NOT include any prices.

Returns

We accept returns at no charge. When a return is received our receiving department will email you that the package has been returned.

Returned books or other products are not reused and we do not credit your account for return orders.

We do not have the staff to thoroughly review each return to determine if it can be restocked and reshipped, so returns are recycled and not reused.

We do, however, offer you the ability to customize the package slips to include your return information and address if you would like returns sent to your office. This is a popular choice, as often authors can then re-use the books as promotional products, gifts or sales at live events.

Invoicing & Payments

Within the first 1-2 days of each month you will receive an email invoice from Vervante Accounting. The invoice is a one line item invoice for the orders and postage we shipped for you the previous month. Details for this invoice are available online in the reports section of your account.

The credit card on file will be charged within the next 1-2 days. If you pay by check, wire transfer or PayPal payment is due immediately.

To view up-to-date monthly activity or past monthly statements, go to your Author Dashboard and select the "Monthly Activity" or "Statements" links in the Reports & Statements section.

The accounting report will provide you with a detailed line item breakdown for a selected date range. This report breaks down the product cost and shipping costs for accounting purposes.

The marketing report will provide you with an export of all information on the order such as customer name, email address, address and item(s) ordered.

Statements

The Statements links will show you all past invoices and payments with links to download each one if needed.

Inventory

If we have products in stock for you that have been supplied to us or you have pre-ordered and paid for, these items will be listed on your Author Dashboard. You set the minimum quantity and when we reach this amount an automatic email will be sent notifying you that we have reached the re-order point. Inventory numbers are updated when orders are shipped.
