CUSTOM PRINTED Die-Cut Tabs

TAB PAGE SETUP

Die-cut tabs are 1/2" wider than the interior page of your products.

Example of tabs for 8.5x11 page size


- Page size: 8.5"x11"
- Tab page size: 9"x11"
- Center content on tab within body of tab: 8.5"x11"
- Additional ½" will be die cut tab
- Tabs need ¼" bleed and crop marks
- PDF would be 9.5" x 11.5" included bleed, finished size: 9"x11"
- Use the size of the tabs when creating your covers


DETERMINE TAB SIZE

To calculate the spacing of tabs, divide the height of the page by the number of tabs in your bank.

Example For Bank of 6 Tabs:

- Page size 8.5" x 11"
- Divide 11" (page height) by 6 (number of tabs) = 1.8" per tab
- Each tab will be 1.8" in length by .5" wide





CUSTOM PRINTED DIE-CUT TABS

2 – SIDED TABS

Tabs can be printed single-sided or 2-sided. The body of the tab can contain graphics, or just the tab extension can be printed.

For side 1 of the tabs, 1/2" for the tab to the right side of the. Center the content for the body of the tab within the page size – not the width of the tab.

For side 2 of the tabs, add 1/2" for the on the left side of the page. Center the content for the body of the tab within the page size – not the width of the tab. Remember that ½" will be trimmed from the tab side of the sheet.

Tabs need bleed and crop marks.

IMPORTANT TIP:


Tabs are inserted before an odd-numbered page in your PDF. Even numbered pages in a PDF are side two of a sheet of paper so a tab cannot be inserted before an even page number.

Options for Tabs:

- Printed single-sided or 2-sided.
- Printed in color or black & white
 - Printed on 120# cover stock
 - Coated or uncoated paper stock uncoated for
- tabs that will be written on

Clear or colored mylar can be added to the tab extension to help protect the die-cut tab

Tab length: minimum $\frac{3}{4}$ " – largest 3", width is always $\frac{1}{2}$ "





CUSTOM PRINTED DIE-CUT TABS
