1 CHOOSE A THEME

2 SELECT YOUR ART

If you are an artist, you can create the coloring designs yourself. If your artistic talents don't go beyond sketching stick figures, no worries! There are thousands of royalty-free stock images available for purchase online that can be used to create coloring books. If you choose to purchase stock images, just be sure you have the correct licensing rights.

Most use a coloring image for their covers that is either partially or completely filled in to catch the eye of potential buyers and give them a sneak peek of what's inside.

If you are a children's book author, here's a fun idea – transform your children's book into coloring book.

You can do this by removing the color from the book's illustrations to create a version that kids can color themselves.



3 DECIDE ON THE DETAILS

Paper Thickness

Coloring books can be printed single-sided or double-sided. If you choose to print double-sided, a thicker-weight paper won't bleed through. We recommend 28# paper.

Binding Choices

Perfect binding is a traditional choice for coloring books. But if you want to really stand out you can use spiral binding or saddle stitching so the coloring book can lay flat for ease of use.

Horizontal vs Vertical

Most coloring books are printed vertical, so creating one that is horizontal with spiral binding that allows it to lay flat will definitely make yours unique!

Perforated Pages

Make it easy to remove or share pages by perforating some or all of the inner pages.

Page Size

We can print your coloring book any size, so you can stick with the standard letter size that is super popular or make a fun, smaller sized color book.



4 WRITTEN CONTENT

Your coloring book will need some written content. You can include pages such as an introduction, front matter with copyright and contact information, and maybe something at the end to invite them to visit your website, sign up for your newsletter, or purchase more books, etc.

5 SET UP FOR PRINTING AND ORDER PROCESSING
